

## **Agreement**

on cooperation in the sphere of medical molecular immunology, allergology and medical genetics in joint scientific investigations in the course of post-graduate medical education for the period 2015-2025 between

## § 1 Purpose of this Agreement

Considering the necessity of strengthening cooperation in the sphere of scientific and clinical investigations and training of medical specialists who master new diagnostic and treatment technologies in the sphere of molecular allergology, immunology and medical genetics the parties have declared their readiness to pursue the following aims within the framework of the planned International Network of Universities for Molecular Allergology and Immunology (INUNIMAI), whereby the parties agree that the details of such indented joint cooperation and in particular the details of the intended cooperation described below, need to be discussed and agreed upon in further written agreements during the upcoming negotiations:

- Conduct of joint scientific investigations, symposiums, conferences, etc.
- Implementation of joint training programs in the course of post-graduate medical education on medical genetics and molecular immunology
- Preparation of joint printed issue
- Perform financial support of the agreement at the expenses of internal funds, voluntary contributions of business entities, non-governmental organizations on the terms determined by the parties
- Send working groups and other consultative bodies of scientists and specialists for the implementation of main tasks indicated in the agreement
- Actively participate in forming the Coordination council of International Network of Universities for Molecular Allergology and Immunology which will provide coordination of activity between Coordinator and CMG.

## § 2 Admission of new members

The parties herewith authorize Coordinator to add new members to the Network on behalf of each party. A new member enters the Network upon signature of the Accession document in Annex I between the new member and the Coordinator.

The parties warrant that they have the full legal capacity to enter into this Agreement.
